<h2>Hybrid Tea &amp; Grandiflora</h2>	<p><b>All-American Magic™</b> (Grandiflora) Red &amp; Yellow striped. Disease resistant and hardy rose. The large, rounded blooms emerge red &amp; yellow striped, and fade to red &amp; cream, with glossy foliage. Slight raspberry scent.</p> <p><b>Ch-Ching!™</b> (Grandiflora) Lemony yellow color sport of <i>Strike It Rich</i>. Super vigorous, bushy, clean plant, flowers heavily with a strong sweet spicy &amp; fruity fragrance.</p>	<p><b>Over the Moon™</b> (Hybrid Tea) Deep-apricot buds open to slightly-softened peach tones. Large, classical rose shape creates a perfect bouquet of fruity scented blossoms. Vigorous, bushy plant gets better with age.</p> <p><b>Secret's Out!™</b> (Hybrid Tea) Twist on <i>Secret</i>, but this time with a stronger, spicy scent. Pure white, medium, cup-shaped blossoms stand out against dark green leaves. Founded by Witherspoon Rose Culture.</p>	<p><b>Sedona™</b> (Hybrid Tea) 2010 J &amp; P Rose of the Year Warm shades of reds, corals, and oranges on these high-centered flowers are reminiscent of the picturesque red bluffs and beautiful sunsets of the high desert. The strong, pear-scented blooms reveal undertones of coral pink as the nights cool.</p>
<h2>Florabunda, Climbers, &amp; Mini</h2>	<p><b>Can-Can™</b> (Climber) Magenta red to light pink flower with a creamy white center. This climber may grow up to 10' in height. Excellent disease resistant leaves, and continuous flowering make this a hassle free climber for any archway or trellis.</p> <p><b>Cinnamon Girl™</b> (Mini) Smoky orange blooms with a creamy white reverse. This little mini grows to about 24" tall, but is packed with these uniquely colored blooms against glossy, dark green foliage. Useful as accent plants and mixed in with perennial beds.</p> <p><b>Drop Dead Red™</b> (Floribunda) Deep red blossoms are set against highly-glossy deep green leaves. The deep color doesn't fade as the blooms age. A welcome showy addition for any landscape.</p>	<p><b>Easy Does It™</b> (Floribunda) <b>2010 AARS Award Winner</b> Developed from the world-famous Harkness family in England, the only winner of the AARS 2010 trials has proven to be a great performer across the country. It takes to a variety of climates &amp; conditions. Multi-colored blossoms of peach, pink, and honey-yellow cover the entire plant throughout the season. Disease resistant, glossy green leaves, off-set the moderately fruity fragrance from these scalloped ruffled blossoms.</p> <p><b>Julio Iglesias™</b> (Floribunda) Great performer for the sunny climates of the west coast. Hot pink and white striped blooms with a strong citrus and verbena scent make this a striking Floribunda.</p>	<p><b>Monkey Business™</b> 2010 J &amp; P Floribunda of the Year Bright banana yellow blooms. Huge clusters of high-centered blooms create perfect, ready-made bouquets with a single snip. Brighten the indoors with these slightly licorice scented blooms.</p> <p><b>Pumpkin Patch™</b> (Floribunda) Coppery buds open into clusters of fruity fragranced orange blossoms. Medium bloom sized flowers in large clusters nestle against shiny green leaves. Does best with a little afternoon shade.</p> <p><b>Sweet Intoxication™</b> (Floribunda) Rich magenta blooms intoxicate with a strong clove fragrance. Bred from the two most powerfully fragrant roses ever introduced (<i>Melody Parfume</i> x <i>Perfume Perfection</i>), this new rose certainly lives up to its name. Non-stop color and fragrances lasts season after season.</p>
